## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS SHEET As of January 1, 2018

## Q: What are my voting rights in the condominium association?

- A: On all matters upon which the membership shall be entitled to vote, each member shall be entitled to one vote for each unit owned.
- Q: What restrictions exist in the condominium documents on my rights to use my Unit?
- A: Please see Article 12 "Residential Use Restrictions Applicable to Condominium Units" on page 10 for all the details.
- Q: What Restrictions exist in the condominium documents on the leasing of my Unit?
- A: Each unit is hereby restricted to residential or rental use by only the owner thereof, his immediate family, guests, invitees or lessees. Such rental may be weekly or for a longer term.

## Q: How much are my assessments to the condominium association for my Unit type and when are they due?

- A: Assessments for the Units are due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month. The 2018 monthly assessment amounts are:
  - Floors 1 -6 \$1,500
  - Floors 7 and 8 \$2,830
- Q: Do I have to be a member in any other association? If so, what is the name of the association and what are my voting rights in this association? Also, how much are the assessments?
- A: No.
- Q: Am I required to pay rent or land use fees for recreational or other commonly used facilities? If so, how much am I obligated to pay annually?
- A: No not applicable.
- Q: Is the condominium association or other mandatory membership association involved in any court cases in which it may face liability in excess of \$ 100,000? If so, identify each such case.
- A: No.
