FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS SHEET As of August 1, 2018

- Q: What are my voting rights in the condominium association?
- A: On all matters upon which the membership shall be entitled to vote, each member shall be entitled to one vote for each unit owned.
- Q: What restrictions exist in the condominium documents on my rights to use my Unit?
- A: Please see Section **10. Use Restrictions** on page 14 in the Declaration of Condominium.
- Q: What Restrictions exist in the condominium documents on the leasing of my Unit?
- A: Each unit is hereby restricted to residential or residential-rental use with a minimum rental term of one (1) year.
- Q: How much are my assessments to the condominium association for my Unit type and when are they due?
- A: Assessments for the Units in the condominium are due *monthly*. The monthly assessment amount is \$1,350.00. The fiscal year is August 1 July 31 of each year.
- Q: Do I have to be a member in any another association? If so, what is the name of the association and what are my voting rights in this association? Also, how much are the assessments?
- A: No.
- Q: Am I required to pay rent or land use fees for recreational or other commonly used facilities? If so, how much am I obligated to pay annually?
- A: No not applicable.
- Q: Is the condominium association or other mandatory membership association involved in any court cases in which it may face liability in excess of \$ 100,000? If so, identify each such case.
- A: No.
